CENTRAL ADDITION TO TOWN OF LOGAN.

I hereby certify that what I have laid out for the Council of the Incorporated Village of Logan in the County of Hocking and State of Ohio, as an Addition to said Village to be denominated Central Addition, a part of the south West quarter of section No. 12, Township No. 14 Range No. 17, contained in the following description. - Beginning at the south east corner of the west half of the south west quarter of Sec. 12 Township 14 Range 17, thence west 2.55 chains thence north 20° west 5.48 chains thence west .50 links thence north 90 links, thence north 28° west 4.32 chains, thence north 80° East 1.26 chs to North line of Main Street, thence north 45° East 6.75 chains to south line of Hunter Street thence East 2.16 chains to the east line of said west half of south west quarter, thence south 3 1/4° East 16.18 chains, to beginning, containing 7.95 acres, and including in said addition lots numbered 375 to 397 inclusive as delineated on the plat hereto attached, Lots 123 & 397 are composed of Original lot 123 and a part of the above real estate, subdivided equally East and west as shown on the plat, the North half retaining the old number and the south half being numbered 397. Lots 130 and 394 are composed of Original lot 130 and a fraction of the above described tract of land, subdivided equally north and south, the west half retaining the old number and the east half being numbered 394, lots 139 and 393 are composed of Original lot No. 139 and a fraction of

the above described land subdivided equally north and south, the west half retaining the old number, the east half being number 393. Lots 140 and 141 are composed of Original lots 140 and 141 with sufficient of the above described land added to each, as to make the lines of said lots right angles and the lots retaining their original numbers Lot 153 and 387 are composed of Original Lot 153 and a fraction of said tract of land added thereto and subdivided equally north and south the west half retaining the original number the east half being numbered 387. - The size of each lot is numbered on the plat, in links and fractions of links. Main Street is 125 links wide, and corresponds with Main Street in the Original Plat of said Village and is an extension or continuation of the same street, i.e. Crock and Bragg's addition. - Second Street is 100 links wide and is an extension of Second Street in the Original Plat of the Village, this Street East of and parallel to Orchard Street is 100 links wide and denominated Culver's Street, this alley running north and south between Orchard and Culver's Streets is 25 links wide and denominated Kings Alley, the Alley or space east of Culver's Street is 25 links at the southern extremity on Front Street, and 35 links wide on northern end on Hunter Street from part of western space as designated and delineated on plat of Crock and Bragg's addition, the whole width of said space at north being 35 links. The Alleys running East and West are each 25 links wide and correspond with and are continuations of the original alley of said Village. The meaning of Original numbers, as applied to certain Lots in the foregoing description, is the numbers given to those lots as the lots of said Village have been consecutively numbered by the proper authorities, and the numbers by which said lots were known and designated previous to being subdivided, in connection with this addition. A stone is planted at the south east corner of lot No. 389. The green line from South end of Culver's Street north westerly to main thence north easterly to north end of Culver's Street designates the western boundary of said addition. Know all men by these presents that we Oapley Case, Mayor, and William J. James, Clerk of the Incorporated Village of Logan in the County of Hocking and State of Ohio, in pursuance of an ordinance entitled an ordinance "to add an addition to the plat of Logan," passed 2nd 1869 and to take effect June 9th 1869, and by virtue of the authority conferred by the said ordinance, and the resolutions of the Council of said incorporated Village, the said Council having caused the lands described in the attached plat to be platted and laid off into Lots, Streets and Alleys, as an addi-
