This day this cause came on for hearing upon the petition of the said petitioners with the exhibits thereto attached and the evidence.

Upon consideration whereof the Court find that due and legal notice has been given in this case by publication, according to law for more than thirty days prior to this date and that the petition of the said Clarence E. Poston filed in this Court is true. And the Court further finds from the evidence that the said Addition known and designated as the Culver's Assignee's Addition to the Village of Logan, including the subdivision of the Culver estate, as set forth in said petition, ought to be vacated together with the streets, avenues and alleys thereof.


It is therefore considered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the whole of the addition to the Village of Logan known as the Culver's Assignee's Addition and also the subdivision of the Culver estate, being a part of Fractional Lots Nos. 9 and 21, Sec. No. 11, Township No. 14, Range No. 17, Hocking County, Ohio, which is situated just outside of said Village limits and adjoining the same, and laid out and platted as a part of said Culver's Assignee's Addition to the Village of Logan, Ohio, together with all the streets, avenues and alleys thereof, be vacated and held for naught. It is further ordered that the Clerk of this Court certify the proceedings and orders herein made under his hand and seal according to law.
