On the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September 1839 before the subscriber a Justice of the Peace within and for said County personally appeared the said Richard Ankrom and Tracy Ankrom who signed and sealed the foregoing deed and acknowledged the signing and sealing thereof to be their act and deed for the purposes therein expressed and the said Tracy Ankrom wife of the said Richard Ankrom being by me examined separate & apart from her said husband and the contents of said deed made known to her by reading the same in her presence she did declare upon such separate examination that she did voluntarily sign seal and acknowledge the same and that she is still satisfied therewith. And I do further certify that from my own personal knowledge I am satisfied that the said Richard Ankrom & Tracy Ankrom is the persons they represent themselves. Given under my hand & seal

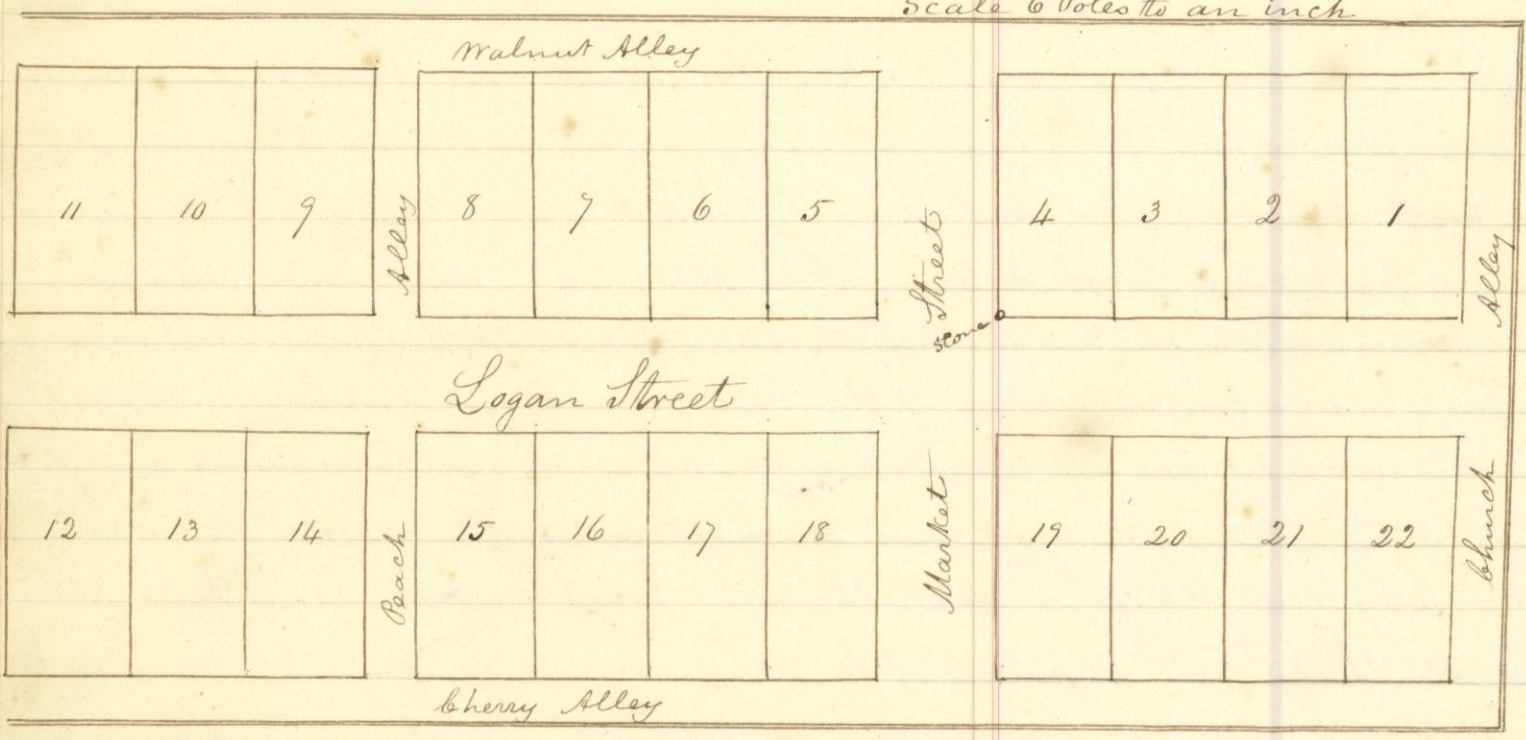

The above is a plat of Gibersonville in Township 12 Range 18. The Town of Gibersonville was surveyed from a part of the East half of the N.E. q<sup>r</sup> of Sec 21 of said Township commencing on the S.W. corner of lot No 4 where is a stone thence N 85° E and S 85° W each lot being four poles in width and at right angles back 55° E and N 5° W Eight poles except Lots Nos 1 and 22 Lot No 1 being 114 links on Walnut alley and in front 4 poles Lot No 22 being 97 links on Logan street Eight poles back and 84 links on cherry Alley the streets being 4 poles in width and the alleys one pole in width
