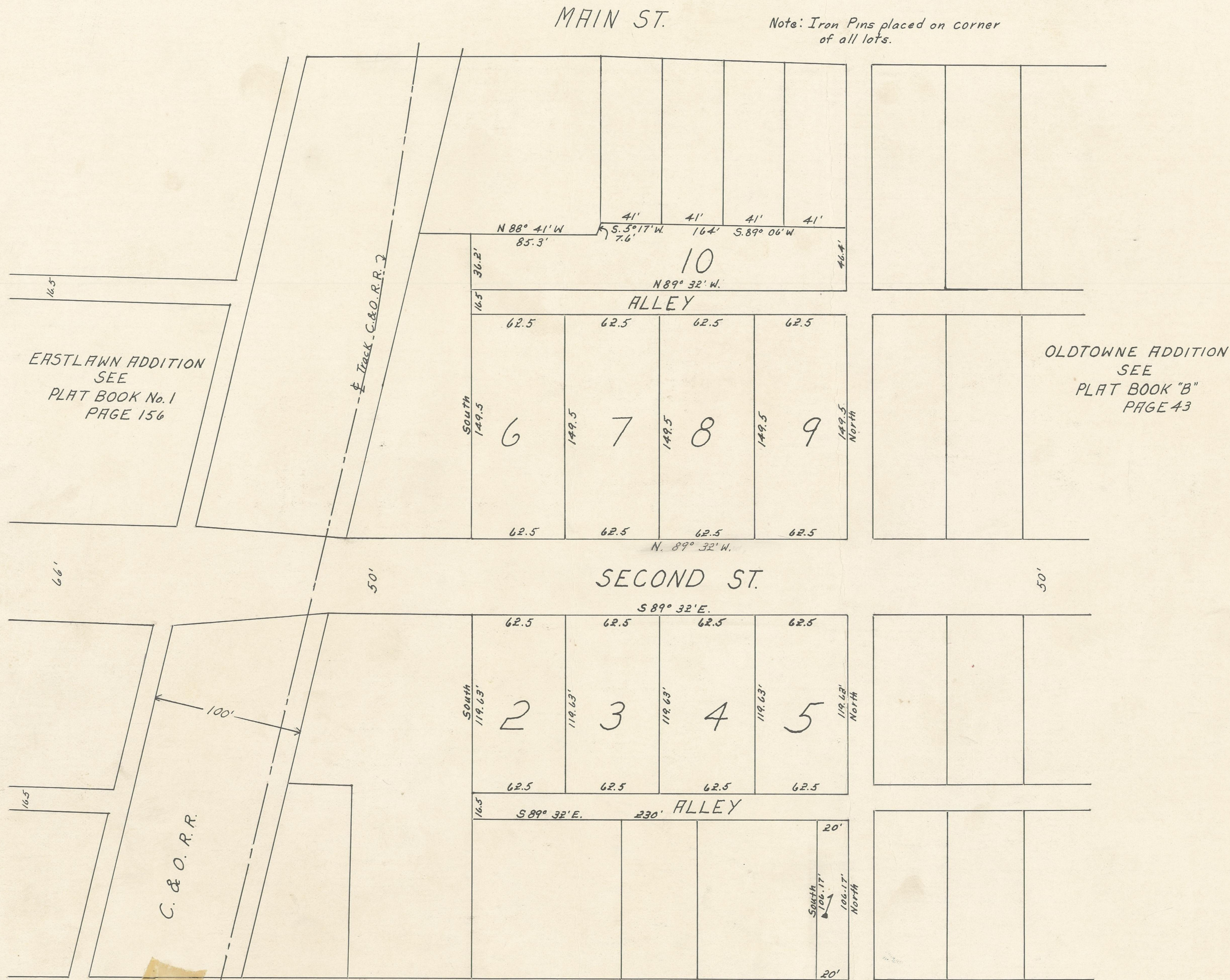


MAP OF
