Description - Main Street is 8 poles wide
 & runs East - Second & Front Streets are 4 poles
 town East - Market St. is 5 poles wide & runs
 North - High, Spring, Mulberry & Walnut Streets
 4 poles wide, & run North - The Alleys are all
 4 poles wide, four run North & three run East - The
 square is 6 poles long & 2 1/2 poles wide - The Market
 is 9 poles long & 2 1/4 poles wide - The In-lots are all 9
 poles long & 4 1/2 poles wide, except Nos 48, 49, 50 & 51, which are
 poles long - The Out-lots are all 12 poles wide
 from North to South & from 25 to 26 poles long from
 East to West - Market Street through the Out-lots
 3 poles wide & runs North - Walnut Street 2 poles
 & runs East - East Street 2 poles wide & runs North
