

PLAT OF MIDLAND PLACE ADDITION TO LOGAN, OHIO

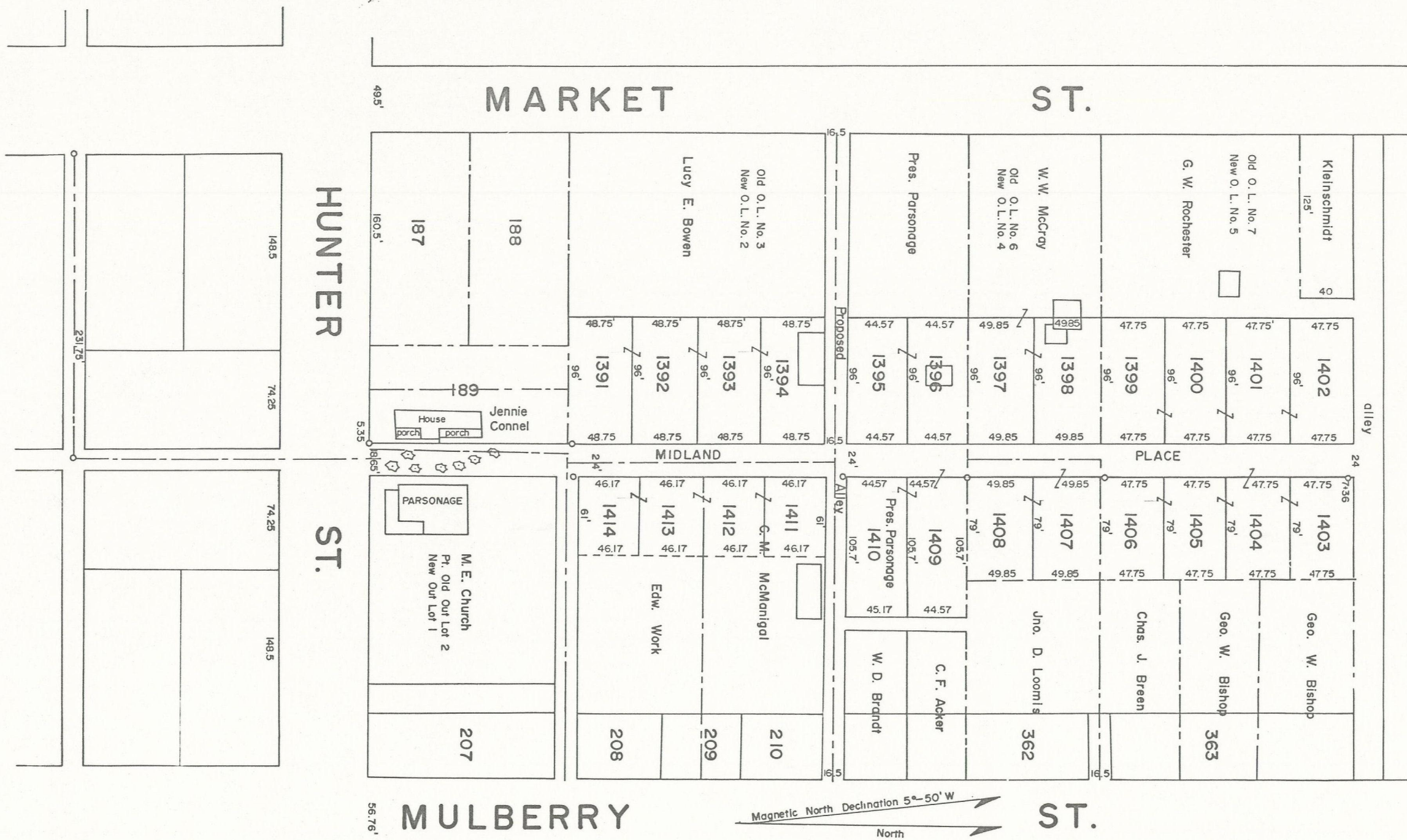
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE; I hereby certify the foregoing is a correct Plat of a subdivision of parts of Out Lots numbers, 2, 4 and 5 revised numbers in the Village of Logan, Ohio, as caused to be surveyed and platted by R.D. McMANIGAL, G.W. ROCHESTER Et al, the subscribers hereto, as an addition to the Village of Logan, Ohio.

All distances are given in feet units, and the bearings and dimentions of all lots, streets and alleys, are as marked on the Plat. The street named "Midland Place" is 24 feet wide and the center line of it is the center line of the alley between Markets and Mulberry Streets as now established South of (Hunter Street) produced North from the South line of Hunter Street to the North line of Out Lot Number 5 from the North line of Hunter Street to the South line of Out Lot No. 2, this street crosses a part of Out Lot Number 1 (Old Number 2) and a part of In Lot Number 189, which are now the property of the First Methodist Episcopal Church of Logan, Ohio and Jennie Connel respectively, and who are not Grantors in the dedication hereon.
