I Emanuel Geisy, surveyor, do hereby certify that the foregoing plat is a correct delineation of the survey of the town of Millville as surveyed by me April 15 AD 1857. All the Lots excepting One, fifteen, sixteen and forty are twenty feet front by 167 feet deep. The survey was commenced at the corner of Lot No 1, where a stone was placed 50 feet from the corner of Lot No 1 on the line bearing North 81° West.

I Emanuel Geisy proprietor of the Town of Millville do hereby set apart for public use all the streets and alleys, and lot twenty-nine for school purposes, and Lot 37 to the Synod of the German Reformed Church of Ohio in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 18 day of April AD 1857
