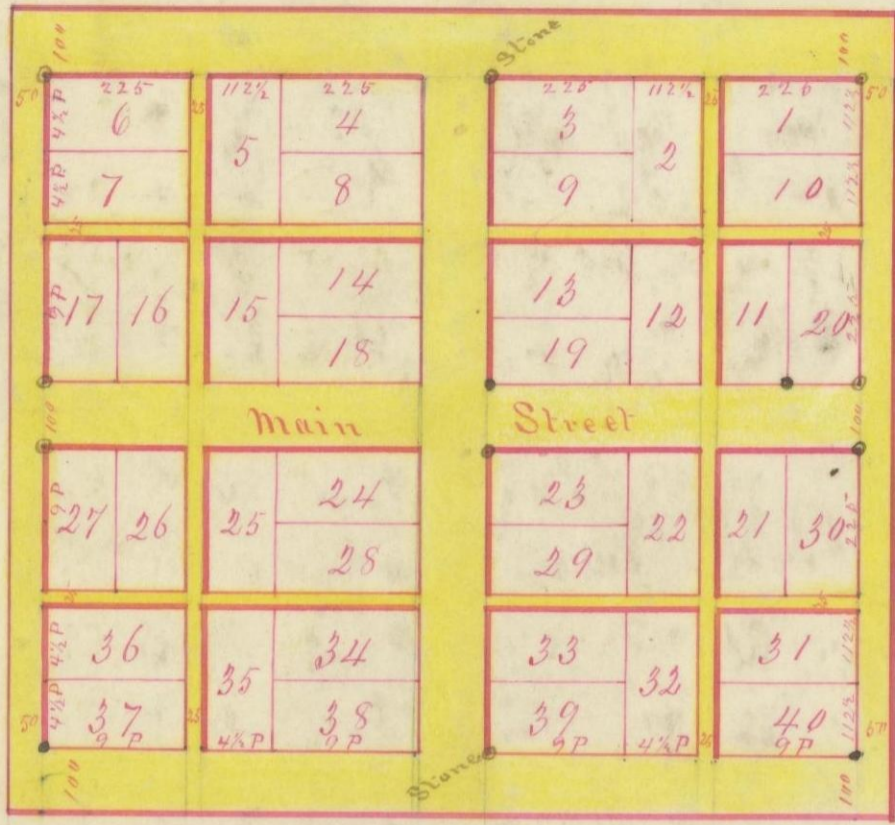


Plat of Point Pleasant, in the County of Hocking and State of Ohio, as laid out on the third of March AD 1838 by Martin Pence.

A plan of the survey of the town of Point Pleasant, in the county of Hocking and State of Ohio on the 3^d day of March AD 1838. The following is the descriptive notes of said town. Beginning forty-two poles east of the NW corner of Section No 19 T 13 R 17, thence south eighteen poles twenty-four links and a half to a stone placed at the NW corner of Lot No 3 thence south 42 poles to the SW corner of Lot No 39, a stone. The streets are four poles wide the alley one, the east and west two poles, The lots are four and a half by nine. The public lots are No 17 and 19. The streets east and west, North and south for a further description see plat.

Lots at whose corners stones are placed are as follows; No 1 NE corner No 3 NW corner No 6 NW cor, No 17 SW corner No 20 (SW) (Record) corner, No 30 NE corner No 23 NW corner, No 19 SW corner No 27 NW corner, No 37 SW corner No 39 SW corner and No 40 SE corner.
