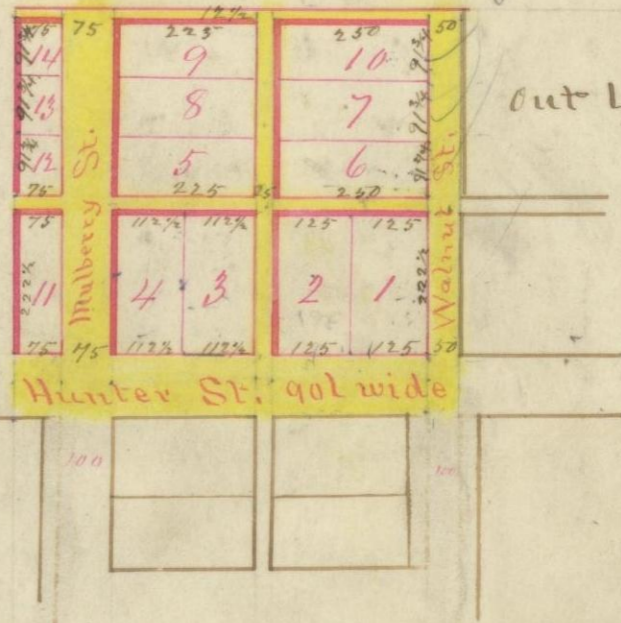

I hereby acknowledge the making of this plat of an addition to the town of Logan to be my voluntary act and deed, October 30, 1848 Daniel B Webster.

I hereby certify that I subdivided Out Lots No 1 and 4 as designated by the foregoing plat, from Lot No 1 to 14 inclusive as an addition to the town of Logan with the length and breadth of each lot written in links upon the plat, Walnut Street is 50 links wide and runs north and south Mulberry street is 75 links wide and runs parallel to Walnut street Hunter Street is 90 links wide, and at right angles with Walnut and Mulberry. The alley on the North side is 12 1/2 links wide the others 25 links. Done at the instance of Case and Saunders, Oct. 30th 1848 By Levi Davis Surveyor H.C. Ohio State of Ohio Athens County ss.
