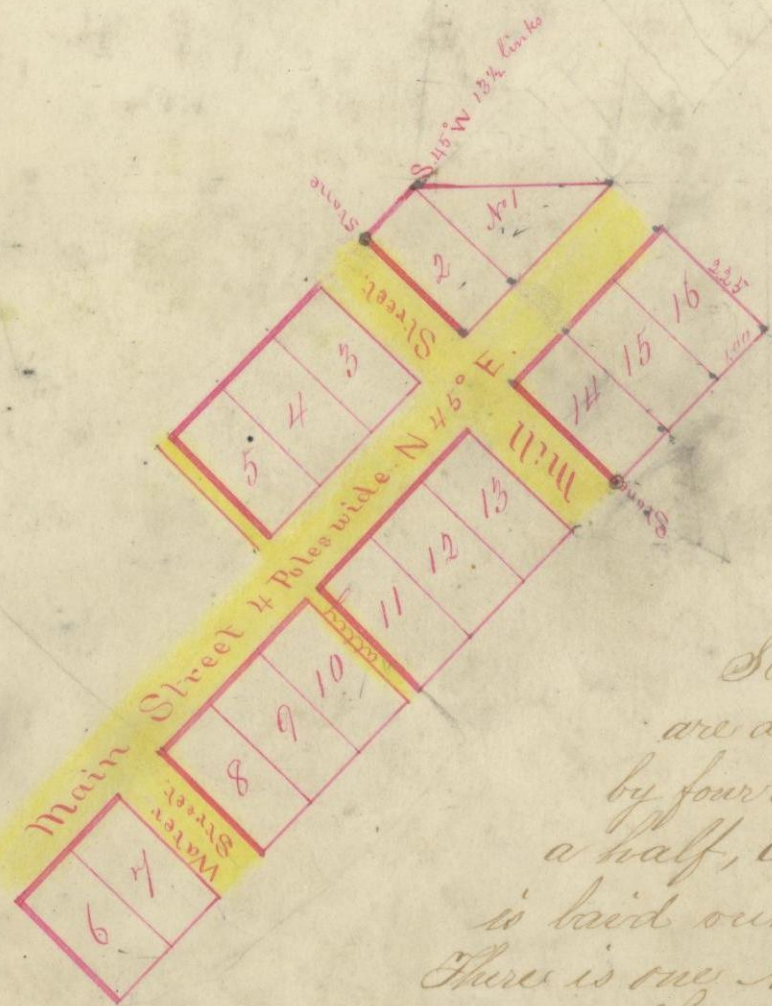


Plat of the town of Bloomingville

Laid out by John Chilcote September 5th 1836

Scale 3 Chains to an inch.



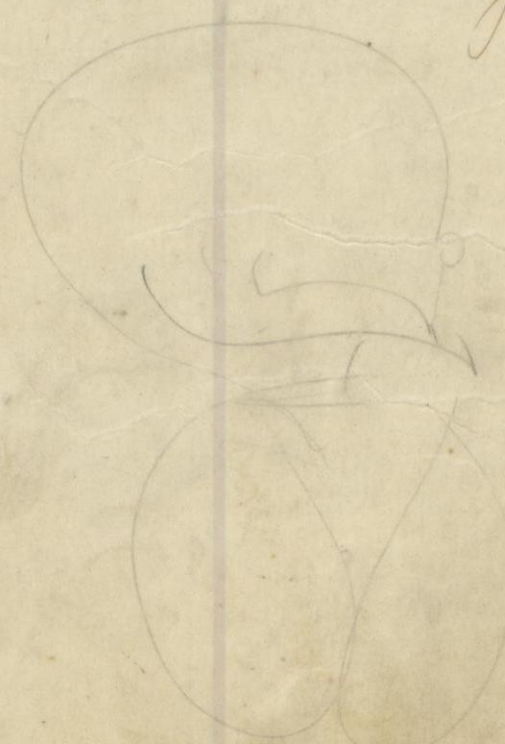
Beginning at the North east corner of the North west quarter of Section 20 Township 11 Range 18 near the half mile post upon the north side of this section thence South 45° west with Main Street, Main Street is four poles wide, and Mill Street and water street are also four poles wide, the length of the lots is nine poles by four and one half poles wide, containing forty perches and a half, except lot No 1, contains more or less. The town is laid out at a variation of 45 degrees from the meridian. There is one Alley one pole wide, all the streets are four poles wide, and there are two stones planted on Mill Street 22 perches distant, one at the South east corner and the other at the North west corner of Lots No 2 and 14. There has been sixteen lots laid out for John Chilcote on Queri creek, at the Mill formerly owned by Christian Eby. I do hereby certify the same to be a true plat to the best of my knowledge. Given under my hand and seal, this 5th day of September AD 1836. Laid down by a scale of twelve perches to the inch.

State of Ohio Hocking County Ss. - Before me Daniel Harsh one of the acting Justices of the Peace in and for the county aforesaid, personally came John Chilcote, proprietor of the within town plat, and acknowledged the same to be laid off as set forth in said plat, and the streets and alleys are to the use of the public agreeably to the within survey.
