I hereby certify that I laid out for Samuel Johnson of Washington and Philip Daine of Swan Townships Hocking County Ohio, as proprietors the town of New Mount Pleasant, in aforesaid townships, all the lots from No 1 to 37 inclusive with their courses and distances as laid down on the above plat, and stumps planted at the corners of every lot north of Township street. The width of the alleys are designated by figures written crosswise on them showing the number of links. The distances of alleys and lots are all taken in chains and links. Main street is sixty feet wide, and runs N. 13° E. Township street is 33 feet wide 18 feet on the north side of the township line and 15 feet on south side of said line. East Street is 25 1/2 feet wide and runs N. 13° E. All the lots from No 1 to 23 were laid out for said Johnson, lying in the SW corner of the SW quarter of section 34 Sp 13, R 17, all the lots from No 24 to 37 inclusive were laid out for said Daine, lying in the NW part of NWqr section 3. T 12 R 17. I certify that the above is correct given under my hand this 20 day of Dec. 1845.
