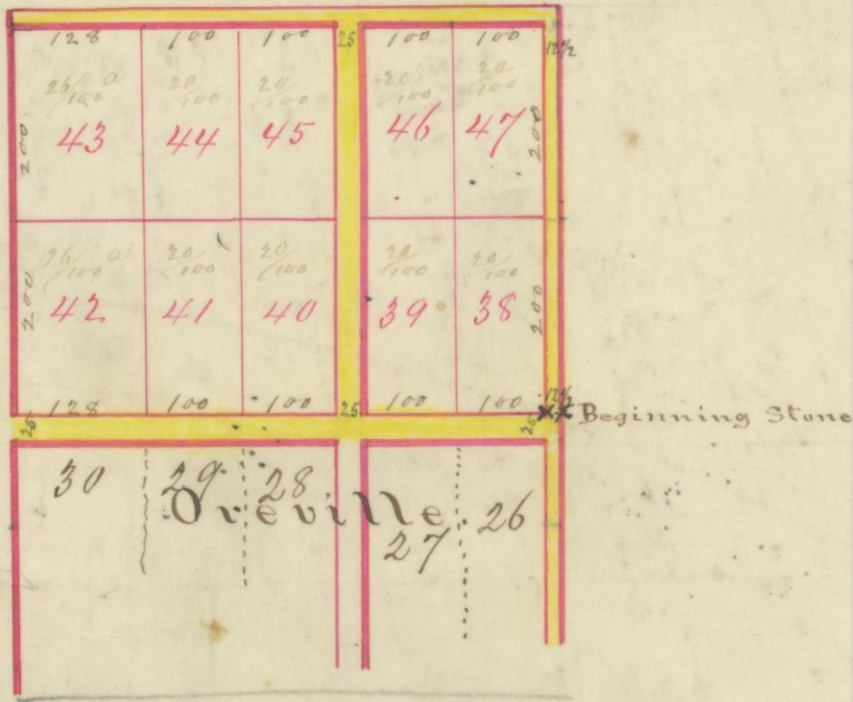


James Lanning's Addition to Creville

I hereby certify the foregoing to be a correct plat of James Lanning's addition to the town of Creville, Hocking County Ohio, Beginning 12 1/2 links East of the North East corner of Lot No 26 in the town of Creville Hocking County Ohio thence West 566 chains to a post thence North 4.38 chs to a post, thence east 5.66 chs to a post, thence S. 4.33 chs to beginning, containing two and fortyeight hundredth (2.48) acres.

The said tract contains 10 lots designated by the plat. The regular lots are 100 links wide front and extend back 200 links and contain 1/5 of an acre, Lots Nos 42 and 43 are fractional, the length, breadth and quantity they contain are written on them respectively, and all other distances, width of streets and alleys are written in links on the plat, and a stone is planted at the South East corner of lot No 38. Surveyed December 12th 1872 by James Davis Dept Sur^r H.C.O.
