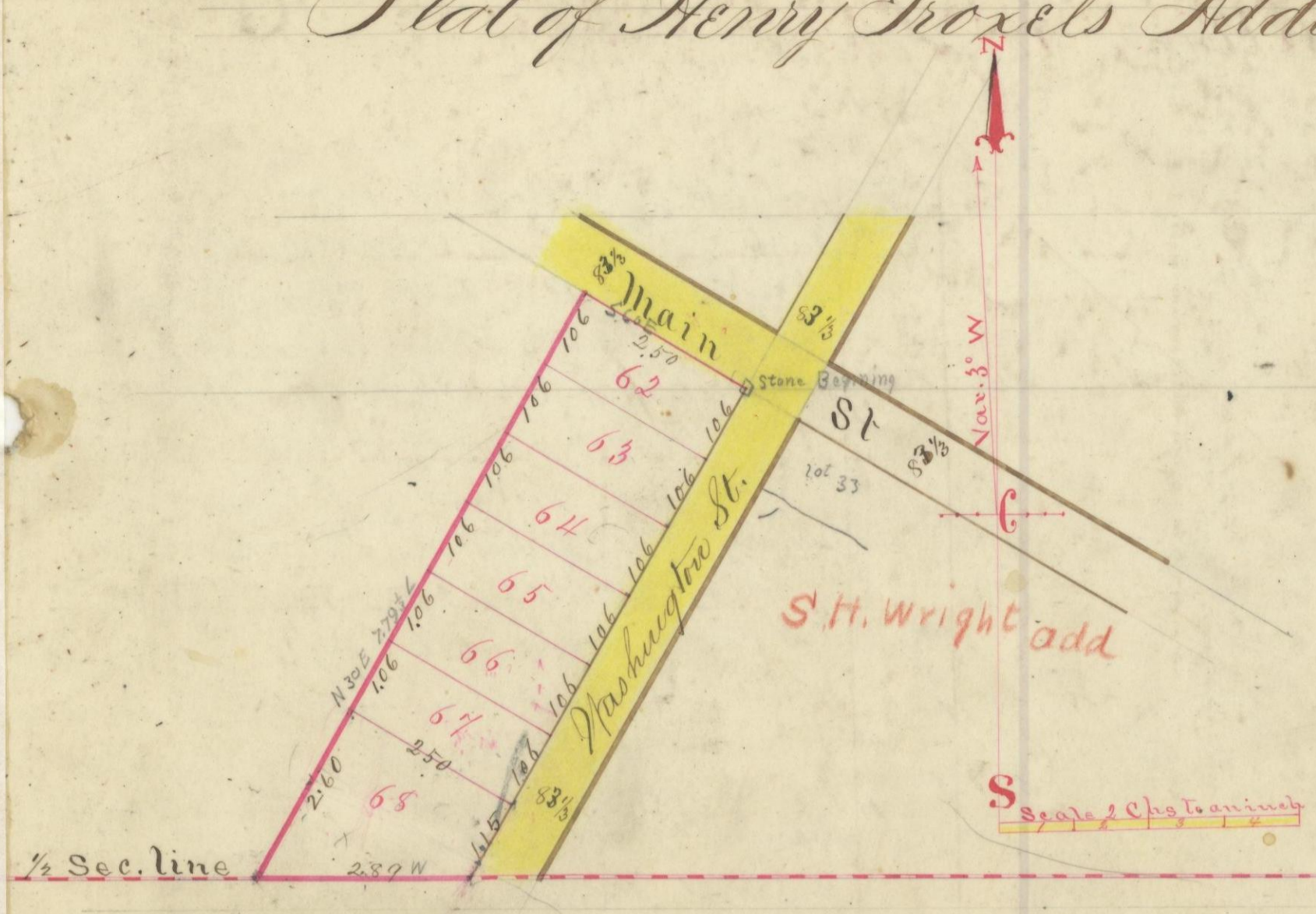

I certify the above to be a correct plat of Henry Troxell's Addition to Millville, being a part of fractional Lot No 4 Section No 23 Township No 15 Range No 15, Hocking County Ohio, Beginning at a stone on the west side of Washington Street from which the N.W. corner of Lot 33 in said village of Millville bears south 6° East 8.33 1/2 links thence S 30° W 7.57 chs thence N 30° East 7.79 1/2 chains, thence S 60° E 2.50 chains, thence S 30 1/2 W 8.33 1/2 chs to beginning, containing 2.26 acres. said tract contains 7 lots as designated by the plat, the length and breadth are written in links on the plat, and a stone planted at the N.E. corner of lot No 62 in said addition.
