The Board after patiently hearing the arguments by counsel for applicants and for remonstrators, on motion continued the case for correction until Monday May 13 A.D. 1889 at 10 o'clock - By vote Yeas 3 Nays 0.

The Board of Commissioners after a careful examination of the petition and the law pertaining to the creation of Villages do find that the petition contains all the matters required, that its statements are true, that the name proposed is appropriate, that the limits of the proposed corporation are accurately described, and are not unreasonably large or small, that the map or plat is accurate, that the persons whose names are subscribed to the petition are electors residing on the territory, that notice has been served as required, that there is requisite population for the proposed corporation; The Board therefore deem it right and proper that the prayer of the petitioners be granted, and do hereby direct the Auditor to enter the proceedings to that effect on the journal, also to prepare a transcript of the same for the County Recorder.
