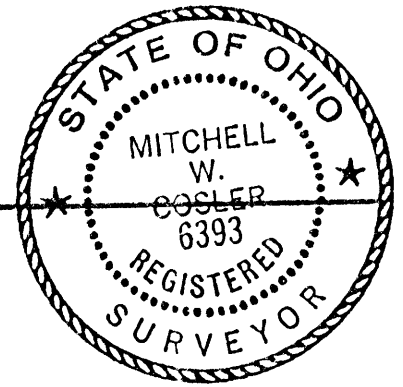

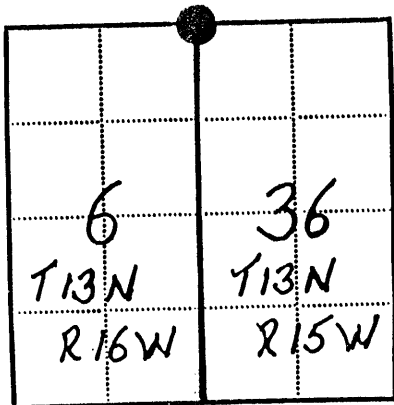

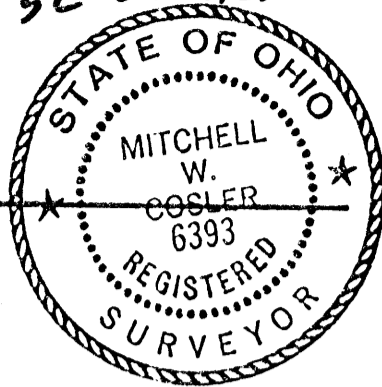

Cosler, do hereby certify that on the 3rd day of March, 1982, I found evidence of the Section 14 North corner of Sections 36 and 31 Township 14 North, Range 15 and 16 West, Ohio River Survey, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations:

The original survey was in 1790 by Ebenezer Buckingham at which time he set an elm post corner on the east side of steep hill. Bearing trees were: Hickory 12" W. Oak 24"

Subsequent restorations were:

- 1. Large Book of Surveys, Page 303, Perry County, April 20, 1848.
2. Hocking County Book of Surveys, Book 1, Page 314 and 315, December 20, 1911.

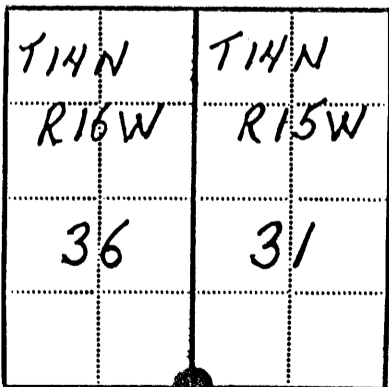

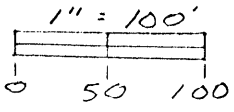

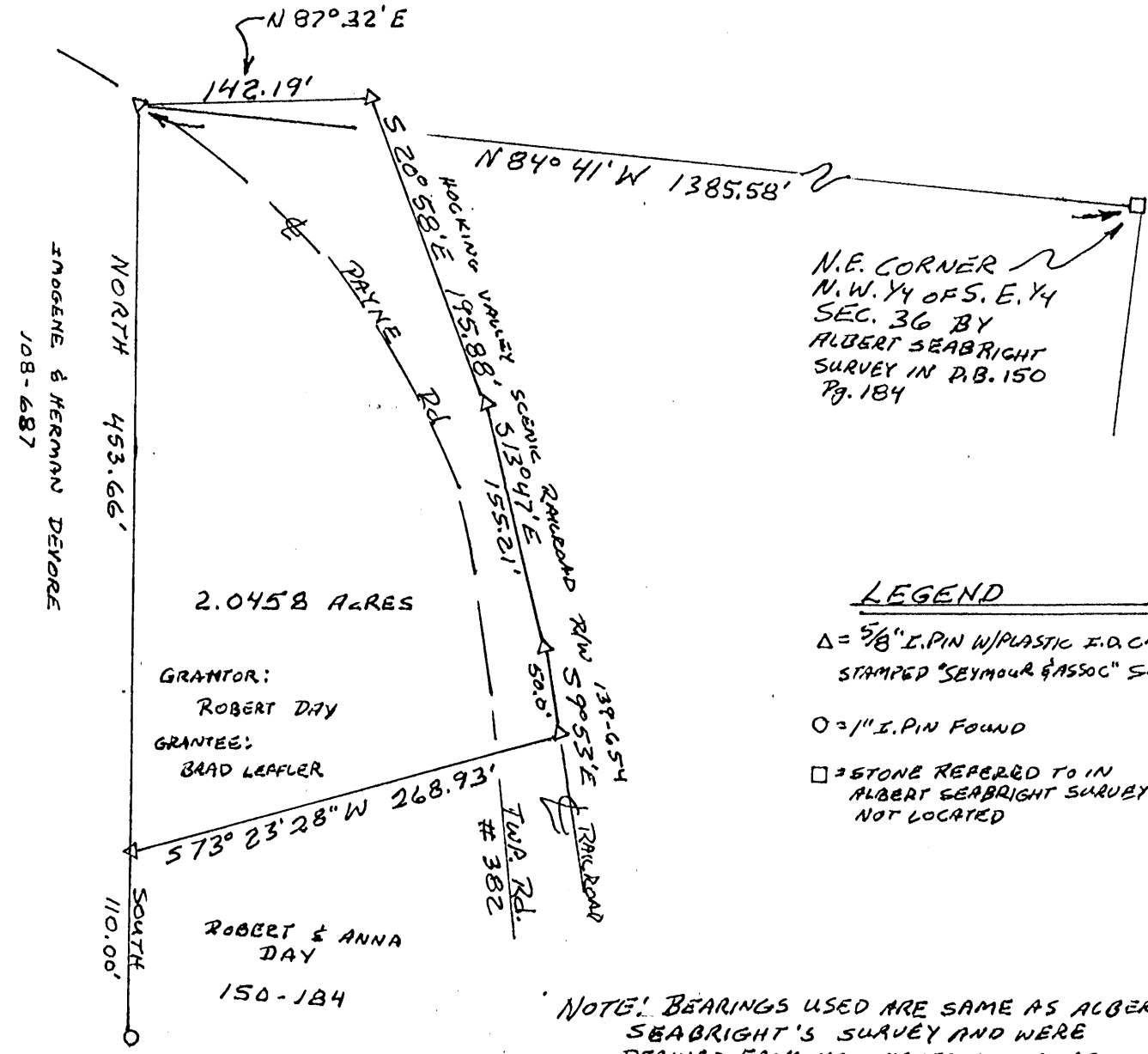

Being a part of the tract of land now or formerly in the name of Robert and Anna Day as recorded in Deed Book 150 at page 184, Hocking County Recorder's Office, said tract being situated in the south half of Section 36, T14N, R16W, Falls Gore Township, Hocking County, Ohio and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" iron pin set in Township Road No. 382 on the grantor's northwest corner which bears from a stone on the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, as referred to in Albert Seabright's survey recorded in Deed Book 150 at page 184, North 84 degrees 41 minutes West 1385.58 feet;

Thence along the grantor's north line, North 87 degrees 32 minutes East a distance of 142.19 feet to a 5/8" X 30" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set on the grantor's northeast corner in the center of the Hocking Valley Scenic Railroad right of way;

Thence along the grantor's east line in the center of said right of way the following three courses:

- [1] South 20 degrees 58 minutes East a distance of 195.88 feet to a 5/8" X 30" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set,
- [2] South 13 degrees 47 minutes East a distance of 155.21 feet to a 5/8" X 30" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set, and
