

## DESCRIPTION OF A 4.771 ACRE PARCEL

Commencing for reference at a $5 / 8$ inch iron pin found with a plastic identification cap inscribed "SEYMOUR \& ASSOC.", said iron pin being the Southwesterly corner of Lot No. 3 Revised and a corner of Lot No. 1 Revised;

Thence $\mathrm{N} 00^{\circ} 48^{\prime} 20^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ along the West line of Lot No. 3 Revised a distance of 48.04 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being the true POINT OF BEGINNING of the parcel herein described;

Thence continuing $\mathrm{N} 00^{\circ} 48^{\prime} 20^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ along the West line of Lot No. 3 Revised and the West line of Lot No. 2 Revised a distance of 662.36 feet to a $5 / 8$ inch iron pin found with a plastic identification cap inscribed "SEYMOUR \& ASSOC." The bearing system for this description is based on the South line of Lot No. 1 Revised and bears $\mathrm{N} 88^{\circ} 12^{\prime} 19^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$ and is for the determination of angles only.

Bearings are based upon the South 3 degrees 40 minutes 16 seconds West line (NAD-83, Ohio South) of the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Good Hope Township. All other bearings are from angles and distances as measured in the field and tied by GPS to the ODOT CORS stations.
