This letter hereby serves as official notice that I rescind the survey for JBH Investments, LLC. that was submitted for review on Wednesday January $20^{\text {th }}, 2021$. This survey was emailed to Frank Nelson under the title, "State Route 374 resubmittal." Included with this letter is a resubmittal of my original survey adhering to the existing centerline of State Route 374 . This decision was made for the following reasons:

- The Ohio Department of Transportation advises my office that they accept a $30.00^{\prime}$ right of way ( $60.00^{\prime}$ Total) each way from the existing centerline of State Route 374.
- ODOT right of way plans dated 1-25-1941 (revised 1-22-1943) are found to be inaccurate; therefore, an accurate centerline retracement is unattainable.
- Laws that govern standards for boundary surveys in Ohio (ORC 4733.37) do not contain language regarding adherence to state right of way easements.
- Hocking County conveyance standards adopted on 4-1-2014 do not contain language regarding adherence to state right of way easements.
