


DETAIL OF PART OF SOUTH LINE OF 11,000 ACRE TRACT IN SECTION 12 STARR TOWNSHIP

EXCHANGE AGREED

TO HAVE EFFECT BY THESE PRESENTS:

CARL C. MATHERNY and FRIEDA M. MATHERNY, husband and wife, of Haydenville, County of Hocking, State of Ohio, in consideration of the exchange of certain land as authorized by the Act of Congress approved March 3, 1925 (43 Stat. 1215), the receipt of which consideration is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, of Washington, District of Columbia, and its assigns, that certain parcel of land situate in the County of Hocking, State of Ohio, and described as follows, to-wit:

RESERVING unto the grantors herein, their heirs, administrators, executors or assigns the right under the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture dated July 3, 1917, to mine or remove coal, oil, gas and clay deposited in or under said land for a period of fifteen (15) years from and after the date of this deed, with full right to the grantors herein, their lessees, successors and assigns at any and all times to enter upon said lands and to mine and remove said coal, oil, gas and clay found therein or thereon.

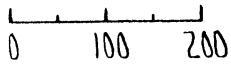
PLAT OF A 8.735 ACRE TRACT FOR RICK JOY
