


PLAT OF 7.67 ACRE TRACT FOR LESLIE AND BETTY TAYLOR






PLAT OF A 14.99 ACRE TRACT FOR LARRY AND JULIE TAYLOR 14.99 Ac.






PLAT OF 16.59 ACRE TRACT FOR LARRY TAYLOR
