

DEED DESCRIPTION

Being a part of land described in Volume 177, Page 374 and Volume 179, Page 359 of the Hocking County, Ohio records.

Being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 13, Range 15, Ward Township in the Village of Murray City, Hocking County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning, for reference, at a point being the southeast corner of Fractional Lot 6, which is also the southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3; thence South 88° 10' 30" West 507 feet (west L.P. Gerstner 1980 survey) with the south line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3 to a point in the centerline of the Old Hocking Valley Railroad; thence with the centerline of the Old Hocking Valley Railroad North 13° 10' 30" East 1071.6 feet to a point; thence North 8° 22' 10" East 160 feet to a point; thence North 55° 33' 29" West 59.91 feet to an iron pin set in the west line of the Old Hocking Valley Railroad and the principal place of beginning of the tract here-in to be conveyed; thence 81.52 feet on a curve to the left with a radius of 904.92 feet the chord of which bears North 3° 44' 51" West 81.49 feet to an iron pin set, passing an iron pin found at 60.01 feet; thence North 86° 56' 22" East 20.30 feet to an iron pin set; thence South 3° 03' 37" East 72.58 feet to a post; thence South 62° 11' 24" West 21.28 feet to the principal place of beginning. The tract as surveyed contains 0.04 acres, more or less, subject to all highways and easements of record.

The bearings in the above description are based on the south line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3 as being South 88° 10', 30" West (west L.P. Gerstner 1980 survey).
