**BILL KAEPPNER:** Bill Kaeppner asked a question about property taxes pertaining to Logan Apartments County Limited Partnership. He said that they are delinquent over \$100,000 and have already paid \$40,000. He asked what is going to be done about this and why it was so delinquent. The Commissioners advised him to speak with the Treasurer.

**REBECCA STARLIN, HAPCAP:** Rebecca Starlin with HAP Community Action addressed the issue that Barb Payne raised earlier in the meeting about the asphalt replacement on Watkins Road in Haydenville. Rebecca said she would check and let Barb know. Rebecca also gave the Commissioners the cost estimates for the proposed Haydenville Flood & Drainage Amendments for the 2008 grant. The estimates included the cost to address more drainage issues, as well as an estimate for more improvements to the park. The Commissioners would like to see the drainage issues addressed with the addition of a catch basin from the park estimate to be added on to the project. This will cost approximately \$28,000.00 with \$10,000.00 remaining. The Commissioners would like to further discuss were they would like the remaining money to be spent.

APPROVE FLOOD & DRAINAGE PROJECT FOR HAYDENVILLE: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to approve the Flood & Drainage project for the use of the remaining CDBG 2008 Haydenville Flood & Drainage funds and to add the catch basin from the park project to this work, to be done by LA Horn, as well as the engineering work to be done by RJM Engineering, with an estimated cost of \$28,000. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

**REBECCA STARLIN, HAPCAP:** Rebecca Starlin with HAP Community Action asked the Commissioners how they would like to proceed with the issue of the fence that was taken down in Haydenville that was originally on the right of way. The Commissioners would like to check with the Engineer and Prosecutor.
