TRAVEL: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to approve the following request for travel:

REDUCE COUNTY MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT RATE: Motion by Greg Green and seconded by Sandy Ogle to reduce the county mileage reimbursement rate from \$.40 to \$.30, effectively immediately. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

KATE MCGUCKIN-MY SISTERS PLACE: Kate McGuckin with My Sisters Place gave the Commissioners an update on the shelter. She said that they did receive stimulus money to increase the network of safe places to meet in Hocking and Vinton counties and to form advisory boards for those counties as well. She also said that they have purchased a new van and are remodeling the kitchen due to stimulus money and donations they have received.

<u>BILL ACTION:</u> Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to approve the county bills and Then & Now purchase orders dated October 16, 2009 totaling \$90,305.81. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

LETTER CONCERNING CULVERT AND LOST POSSESSIONS: The Commissioners received a letter from a couple on Ohio Avenue that is having problems getting their damaged possessions replaced after their shed was flooded because of a culvert that needed repaired. Greg said he will call them and suggest contacting Community Action.

<u>FURLOUGH DISCUSSION:</u> The Commissioners discussed possible furloughs for their employees for the remainder of this year as well as next year.

<u>AUDITOR KEN WILSON:</u> Auditor Ken Wilson informed the Commissioners the sales tax for August is up compared to last year and added that the year is looking better than projected due to lower spending. Ken discussed furlough days with the Commissioners and reminded the Commissioners that the department head don't have to follow their furlough policy nor do they have to furlough at all if they are able to cut the necessary costs from their budget.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to enter into Executive Session at 11:25 am with Auditor Ken Wilson to discuss Health Insurance trade secrets and contract negotiations. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

EXIT EXECUTIVE SESSION: Motion by Sandy Ogle and seconded by Greg Green to exit Executive Session at 12:05 pm., no action taken. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

RECESS: Motion by Greg Green and seconded by Sandy Ogle to recess the meeting at 12:05 pm. Vote: Ogle, yea, Green, yea, Walker, yea.

RECONVENE: The meeting reconvened at 1:30 pm with Sandy Ogle and John Walker present.

RECORDER SANDY HUNT: The Commissioners discussed the submitted budget with Recorder Sandy Hunt. The budget did not meet the 8% cut. Sandy said she looked at the wrong figure when she calculated the budget but will review it and make the necessary adjustments. She added that she would like to hold off on the furlough option until she can't cut anything else.

JUDGE GERKEN: The Commissioners discussed with Judge Gerken that his budget came short of the requested 8% cut. Judge Gerken said that he cannot cut anymore from his budget. The discussed his budget and that half of the magistrate's salary is paid from Juvenile/Probate. John said he would speak with the Auditor and get back with the Judge. The Judge asked the Commissioners if it would be alright to get an estimate to repair the damaged plaster on the third as a result of leaky roof. Judge said he has some money that he could pay for it. The Commissioners said that would be fine.
